



MAKING DIALYSIS A BREATHABLE AFFAIR WITH SHARP.



Healthcare may be a need for everyone, but experiences of the hospital make or break the trust people put in it. While each hospital has its own issues, one of the tricky ones kept Indraprastha Apollo hospitals awake at night.

CHALLENGE

Indraprastha Apollo Hospital has a state-of-the-art, Dialysis Centre, in a 2500 sq. ft area, treating around 30 patients together. There was a major challenge of smell from the dialyzers and chemicals used in the dialysis process. As a result, the patients were facing immunity issues and were infection-prone. The need was to control and resolve these issues.

SOLUTION

When Sharp was apprised of the situation, we saw the concern as a potential crisis. We carried out an audit of our air-purifier product line and planned strategic set ups of our purifiers to perfectly counter the issues. We placed 13 wall-mounted FUSSIKE air purifiers were set

up to purify the toxic air, without intruding in the functioning of the staff.

RESULT

Performance of the wall-mounted air purifiers was tested out over a period of three months. In the review, Sharp found that the air purifiers were immensely beneficial. The Plasmacluster Ion Technology worked well in countering the smell issues, while them being wall-hung helped in staying clear of the work area.

One of the patients quoted “We used to feel very stuffy, during our visit to the dialysis room. Now, after the purifiers were installed, we find the air much fresher and lighter to breathe. These Purifiers are really good.”

In the end, the air seemed lighter and fresher to the patients, and they felt comparatively less stressed during the process of dialysis.
